2010 Triennium Parental Consent Form.

Your child has expressed an interest in attending the 2010 Presbyterian Youth Triennium which is held on the campus of Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana. As the applicant's parent/guardian, we will be requesting several pieces of information from you. Please assist us in making this trip as memorable as possible by:

1. supporting your child through prayer,
2. helping to ensure that they are available for any meetings prior to Triennium,
3. reading all mailings sent out regarding Triennium preparations,
4. promptly and accurately filling out any forms that we need from you (medical release, event registration).

We understand that you are entrusting your child into the care of adult advisors from this Presbytery, a responsibility that we do not take lightly. Please know that we are available to answer any questions that you may have. You will be provided with the names and addresses of all the adult advisors, contact information for the Presbytery's Registrar, and contact information for the delegation while they are at Triennium. These advisors are aware of the responsibilities that they are assuming and are committed to ensuring that your child is safe and provided a spiritually nurturing experience.

In order to effectively ensure your child's physical safety and spiritual well-being, we ask that you thoroughly understand the behavioral guidelines included in this document. In signing this document, you are giving the adult advisors permission to send your child home if s/he violates the rules set by the Presbyterian Triennium and the Presbytery of Susquehanna Valley. You will be responsible for any cost involved in sending your child home from Triennium. These rules establish proper conduct not only while at Triennium but also as we travel there by bus and gather before and after the event.

Please note, as of November 2009, the official 'Triennium Guidelines for Community Life' have not been posted. We expect them to include the following items:

- Respect the rules and property of Purdue University.
- Refrain from use of alcohol and illegal drugs, refrain from smoking in buildings.
- Refrain from inappropriate sexual behavior, including intercourse with a partner other than a spouse.
- Participate in all regularly scheduled Triennium activities and honor all meeting times.
- Wear name badge and wrist bands at all times.
- Follow curfew rules.
- Sleep in assigned rooms.
- Play audio equipment with the consideration of others in mind.
- Do not leave the university campus unless accompanied by an adult, and only during 'free' hours.
- No weapons of any type are permitted on campus or in transit to the event.

In addition to the official Triennium Guidelines, our Presbytery Delegation will form a Group Covenant at our Pre-Triennium Overnight Retreat which all participants will also be expected to follow.

I have read this Parental Consent Form and agree to all the terms set forth herein. I understand that I am giving my child permission to attend the Presbyterian Youth Triennium and am assuming financial responsibility in the circumstance that my child is sent home from this event due to violating the rules established by the Presbyterian Youth Triennium and/or the Presbytery of Susquehanna Valley.
